



Miss Mission Beach *San Diego*

The Miss Mission Beach Pageant is a fundraising event that donates proceeds to various Adaptive Sports events within San Diego County. The Miss Mission Beach San Diego organization is a 501c3 all volunteer non-profit organization.

We provide the opportunity for young women over 18 years old to compete for the Miss Mission Beach (MMB) title. **MMB is required make numerous appearances during the year on behalf of the Miss Mission Beach Organization at various Adaptive Sports Events, Wheelchair Events, parades and other events.** These events will be scheduled to help promote the Miss Mission Beach Title and support Adaptive Sports Events. It will also give those women who seek a "Miss Title" to go on to other pageants.

Entry packages are due by May 23rd, 2014. A \$100 deposit from the contestant will also be required at this time. This deposit will be returned to the contestant upon check-in the day of the pageant. All checks are to be made out to "Miss Mission Beach San Diego". Contestants are encouraged to have a \$250 sponsor and if possible help raise contributions for the MMB organization. All contributions raised will be provided to the Miss Mission Beach Organization no later than the day of the pageant. Keep in mind this is a 501c3 charity that benefits Adaptive Sports Events in San Diego County and could be a tax deduction.

Pageant Categories include: **Miss Mission Beach 2014, 1st Princess, 2nd Princess and People's Choice.** People's Choice will be determined by crowd response during that segment of the pageant.

We are limited to the number of contestant openings, so please send in your entry forms to reserve a contestant space as soon as possible. **There will be a mandatory contestant meeting one evening during the first week of June.** This meeting will answer any last minute questions and give more details on the Pageant. Contestants are required to attend. The date, time and location will be provided in your confirmation email.

This year's pageant will be held in the Bayview Room at the Marina Village Conference Center on Friday, June 20, 2014 at 7:00 pm. The Marina Village Conference Center is located in Mission Beach at 1936 Quivira Way, San Diego, CA 92109.

Contestants will be provided storage and a changing area during the pageant. **The contestants will not be able to have contact with visitors or guests before or during the pageant.** You will be able to enjoy the party and visit with your friends once the MMB Pageant has concluded. The MMB Pageant will be providing an appearance fee of \$75 to all contestants.

RULES, REGULATIONS & AGREEMENT

I, _____ born on _____
hereby apply for eligibility to participate in the Miss Mission Beach Pageant.

1. I am at least 18 years old. Further I was born a female, am single and not married.
2. I will appear at the appointed time and place for all stage appearances, photos sessions and interviews, unless prevented from doing so for reasons beyond my control or unless I have permission by the pageant director to do otherwise. This also includes reporting to the dressing rooms at the required times during the pageant.
3. I have truthfully disclosed my age, address, place of birth and have willingly disclosed all reasonable, necessary personal data as requested by the Miss Mission Beach Pageant.
4. I understand that if I should obtain any knowledge of the pageant judges, I, my parents, friends, relatives, etc. will not engage any of them in conversation at any time prior to the conclusion of the pageant.
5. I understand that I am accepting the responsibility for representing the Mission Beach area and that my public and personal conduct will be of the utmost concern during my reign. If my moral or personal conduct should for any reason become embarrassing to the Miss Mission Beach organization or the Miss Mission Beach Pageant, I will willingly give up my title and prizes. If I fail to attend the required events all prizes shall be returned to the pageant committee who will transfer the title to the next available court member.
6. I understand that one of the areas of judging will be based on my personal appearance. I agree not to extremely alter my personal appearance should I become Miss Mission Beach, with offensive tattoos or piercings that were NOT present when I won the title and keep this appearance during my rein as Miss Mission Beach.
7. I agree to provide my own transportation to and from all appearances. I live within San Diego County.
8. I understand that I must never have posed naked, worked as a topless model or dancer, or have been, or be currently involved in pornography.
9. I understand that I must use courtesy and proper language at all MMB events, as well as when dealing with other contestants and pageant staff.
10. I understand that if selected as Miss Mission Beach, I cannot use the title to endorse any products or businesses for advertising purposes or make appearances as MMB without authorization of the Miss Mission Beach Pageant Organization.

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11. I agree that if I am successful in being crowned Miss Mission Beach (MMB), or Miss Mission Beach 1st Princess, I am required to attend 8 to 10 events annually in order to qualify for the 2nd half of my prize money (to be paid in March). These events will include adaptive sporting events where I may be required to function as a volunteer in my official capacity as Miss Mission Beach or Miss Mission Beach 1st Princess. Additionally, there will be other public functions (i.e. parades, fundraisers) where I may also be called upon to represent the Miss Mission Beach Pageant. These events vary year to year, therefore dates will be provided to me in a timely manner. I may also submit a request for permission to attend any new event to the MMB Board at any time during my reign, with reasonable advance notice (preferably two weeks), attendance to which may count as one of my required appearances.

Further I agree to abide by the rules as stated and hold harmless the Miss Mission Beach Pageant, the pageant volunteers, the pageant facilities, their owners and staff, and all of their volunteers and staff from loss, costs or damage of any kind to my person or property.

WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND AGREEMENT TO INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS

In consideration of entry into and participation in the activities associated with **MISS MISSION BEACH SAN DIEGO** (herein after “**MMBSD**”) and in recognition of the risk of injury while participating in **MMBSD** activities and as consideration for the right to participate in the activities, I hereby for myself, my heirs, executors, administrators, assigns, or personal representatives knowingly and voluntarily enter into this **WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY** and hereby **WAIVE** any and all rights, claims, or causes of action of any kind whatsoever arising out of my participation and do hereby **RELEASE** and forever discharge **MMBSD** and their affiliates, managers, members, agents, attorneys, employees, volunteers, heirs, representatives, predecessors, successors and assigns, the event site and its agents, attorneys, employees, volunteers, heirs, representatives, predecessors, successors and assigns and all sponsors and/or beneficiaries of **MMBSD** from any and all liability, claims, demands, damages, actions or causes of action of every kind and character now existing or which hereinafter may arise as a result of my participation regardless of cause or whether any injury is caused by the sole, joint, comparative, or concurrent negligence or gross negligence or fault of **MMBSD**, the negligence or fault of myself or third parties, the conditions of the event site or any other cause.

Further and for the consideration herein described, I agree to **INDEMNIFY** and **HOLD HARMLESS MMBSD** against any and all claims, demands, damages, suits or actions of any kind whatsoever for liability, damages, compensation or otherwise brought by me or anyone on my behalf, including attorney’s fees, if litigation arises on account of claims made by me or anyone on my behalf caused by negligence, gross negligence, negligence per se, strict liability arising out of or related to **MMBSD** and/or my participation in **MMBSD** to the extent permitted by law.

I recognize that various photographs, video recordings and/or other media will be taken during **MMBSD’s** activities. I agree to grant **MMBSD** full permission to use any and all photographs, video recordings, or other media of **MMBSD** activities that contain my likeness for the purpose of promoting **MMBSD** or its **SPONSORS** in any manner deemed appropriate by **MMBSD**. I understand I have no right to and shall not receive any monetary payment for any photograph or recording (audio or video) in which I may appear in connection with or relating to **MMBSD**. I further agree to **RELEASE** and **INDEMNIFY MMBSD** for any claims of **NEGLIGENCE, GROSS NEGLIGENCE, NEGLIGENCE PER SE, STRICT LIABILITY** or **LIABILITY** or other fault for claims made that relate to any usage of photographs and/or interviews, including but not limited to damages, losses, costs of defense, attorney’s fees and whether caused by the sole, joint, comparative or concurrent negligence, gross negligence or fault of **MMBSD** or myself or third parties, the conditions of the event site or any other cause.

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PAGEANT CHECKLIST

Below is a list of items you **MUST** have on the day of the pageant. Use this list as a guide and checklist as you prepare for the pageant. It is always a good idea to use it again as a checklist the night before and/or the morning of the pageant, before you leave your house, double check that you have **EVERYTHING** that you will need for the day. If you have any questions, please feel free to call any member of the Pageant Staff.

- 1) Opening on stage appearance – Casual Beach Attire.
- 2) Casual Beach Attire – will be worn for your interview.
- 3) Swimwear – Swimsuit / Bikini
- 4) Cocktail Dress – Final change (crowned in).
- 5) A cover-up – Lightweight cover up (2nd heavier cover up, if needed for weather later).
- 6) Snacks/Lunch/Water – Provided (you will not be allowed to leave the pageant area). It is a good idea to bring your own snacks, if you have any special dietary needs.
- 7) Small make-up bag and mirror to touch up your make-up. You will be having pictures taken prior to and during the pageant. **Be considerate to your fellow contestants.**
- 8) One bag - all of your belongings should be packed into one bag. There will not be enough room in the dressing area for each contestant to have several bags or suitcases.
- 9) Contestants should arrive with hair and makeup completed.
- 10) The Dressing Room is an area that will be shared by all contestants. Please limit your need for running water / sink due to the number of contestants. Be courteous of your fellow contestants. There will be tables and chairs provided in the changing area, they may be used for make up, mirrors, etc.
- 11) **EVERYONE** is responsible for cleaning up the changing area. The staff is there to help you, **NOT CLEAN UP AFTER YOU**. Once you are in your Cocktail Attire, everyone needs to get packed up and everything cleaned up.

8:30 pm	On Stage – Cocktail Attire
9:15 pm	Crowning (MMB, 1 st Princess, 2 nd Princess, People's Choice)

Contestants are expected to be at assigned locations, at the appointed time, in the proper attire. The pageant will not be delayed due to a contestant not being ready for a portion of the event. Once the pageant has concluded and Miss Mission Beach court is crowned, contestants will have the opportunity to walk around the event and socialize with family, friends and guests.
